Pathology Boutonniere Deformity

Disruption of the central band of the extensor tendon (laceration/closed injury/rheumatiod disease)

- > elongation of triangular ligament
- > lateral bands separate
- > head of the proximal phalanx slips through the gap
- > collateral bands of extensor tendon shift palmarly and cross the joint axis towards flexion side


> PIP flexion

All the force of the collateral bands now extend the DIP

> DIP hyperextension

Boutonniere Deformity

Boutonniere: PIP flexion, DIP hyperextension



Central and lateral slip FDP/FDS

Intrinsic tendons joining extensor hood Joint axis
