- **Food:** remember that eating well in Italy is an essential rite!







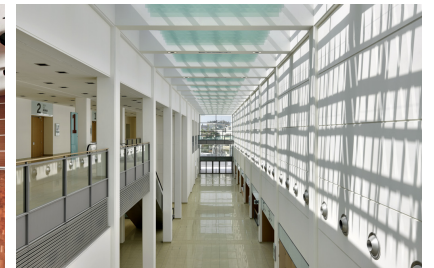
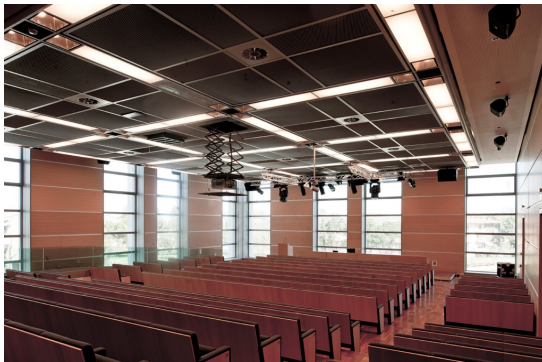
## PALACONGRESSI of Rimini

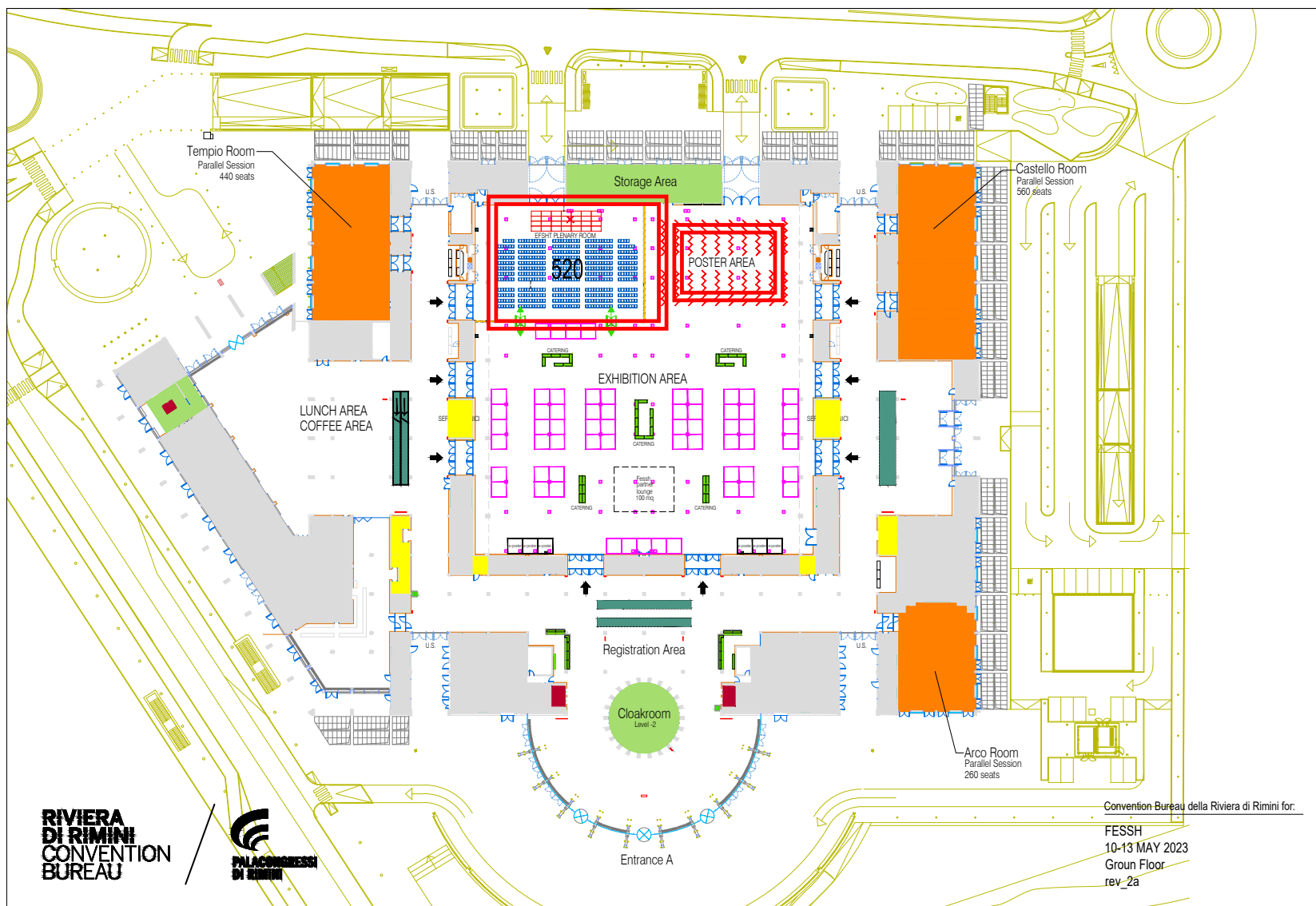
- **By air:** Bologna's International "Guglielmo Marconi" airport is approximately 100 km away from Rimini
- **By train:** Rimini station is just 1.5 km from the Palacongressi; by high-speed connections Rimini is 1 hours from Bologna in 1 hour, 2 hours from Milan and less than 4 hours from Rome
- **By car:** Thanks to the motorway network, Rimini is well connected with the rest of Italy and Europe. It lies on the A14 Milano-Bari motorway and is served by two exits: Rimini Nord and Rimini Sud

Once in Rimini, everything is just around the corner!



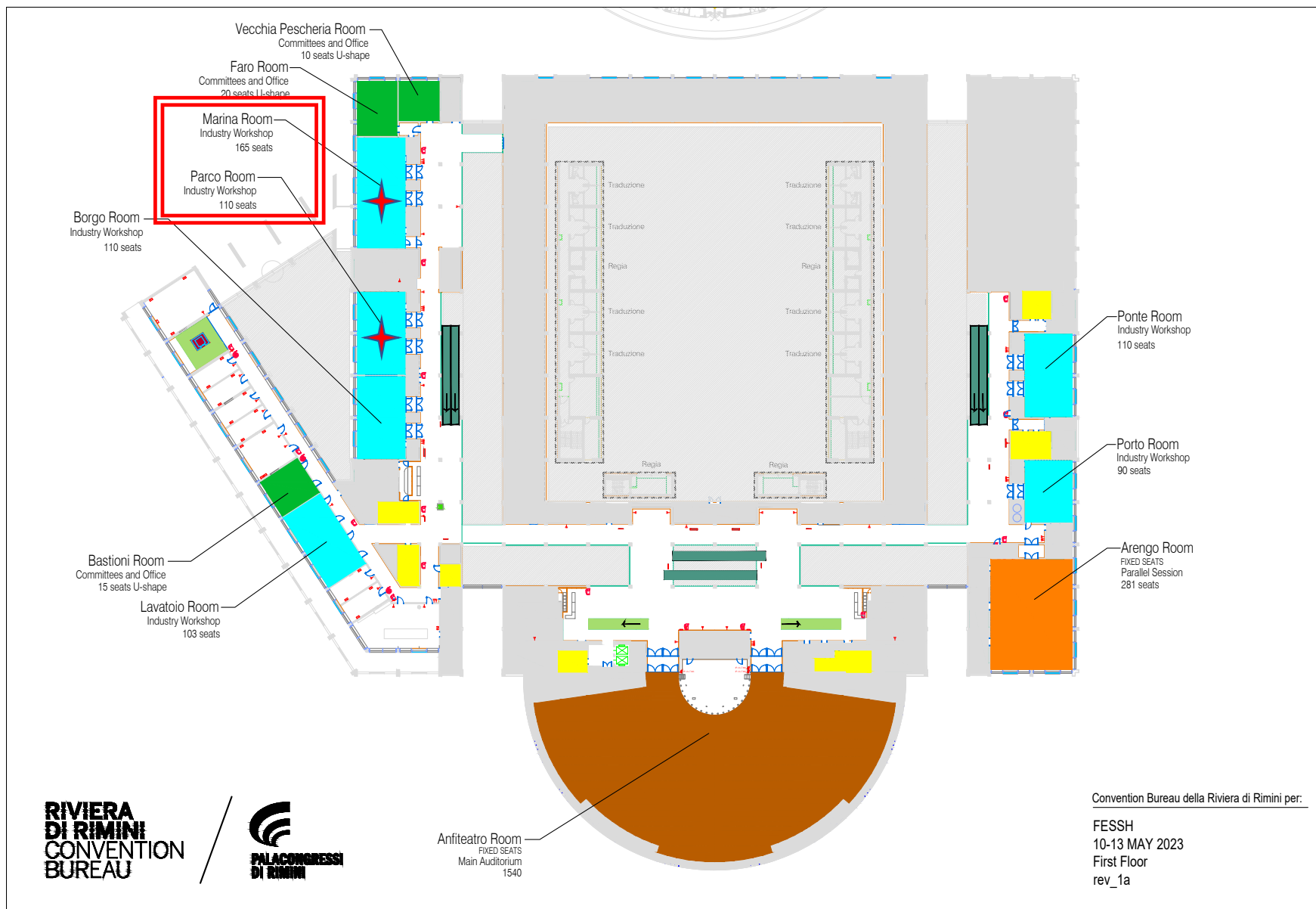
